Sub: Intimation regarding extension of timeline by 90 days in the Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process (“CIRP”) of Sintex-BAPL Limited (“Company”)

Pursuant to Regulation 51 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (LODR) and in accordance with the requirements of clause 24 of Para A of Part B of Schedule III of LODR, please be informed that the Resolution Professional (RP), in connection with the captioned matter hereby places on record that an application (IA/1128(AHM)2022) pursuant to Section 12(2) of the Code, for extension of the period of CIRP of Corporate Debtor, was filed with the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Ahmedabad Bench (Hon'ble NCLT) on 5 December 2022.

In this regard, Hon'ble NCLT vide its order dated 21 December 2022 (written copy received on 23 December 2022), has allowed the extension of 90 days beyond 180 days CIRP timelines for completion of CIR process of the Corporate Debtor.

IA/1090(AHM)2022
